



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

#### 1. Biyani Girls B.Ed. College

BGBC (Biyani Girls B.Ed. College) is run by Biyani Shiksha Samiti in Jaipur since 2006. ALC partnered with the BGBC to implement the program with the students of B.ED., M.Ed., and D.El.Ed courses. A demonstration of the session was conducted with the M.Ed. students in the college before signing the MOU (Memorandum of Understanding). After the first orientation 110 students registered for the program, out of which 59 students were selected, 26 from B.Ed. 1st year, 27 from B.Ed. 2nd year and 5 from D.El.Ed. course for the two batches of Shikshak Chaupal and Blended learning courses. The program was paused on 19th June 2022 after the second batch of the blended learning courses due to examinations.
