Ways to make your **Group Discussion**

What is Group Discussion?

Group Discussion is a tool generally used by B-schools and corporate to judge the personality traits and soft skills of a candidate. In this technique, a group of candidates is given a topic or a situation for discussion by the moderator. They are allowed a few minutes to think about the same or make notes. An ideal group discussion last for 20 to 25 minutes.

Why Group Discussion?

The traits like communication skills, creativity skills, leadership qualities, thinking abilities, interpersonal skills, assertiveness, analytical or logical skills, initiative, team building skills, flexibility, reasoning ability, reasoning ability etc. are generally looked by the recruiter in an aspiring candidate through this technique.

Preparation before GD

The candidates should research the possible topics by reading newspapers, Journals, Television news, books, articles etc., Improve on communication skills and have an in-depth knowledge of current affairs, worldwide. The candidate should be formally dressed and should avoid wearing very colourful clothes. He/she should be in a formal western suit or single colour salwar-kameez with formal sandals or ballerinas. Hair should be properly tied in a ponytail or a bun so that they do not distract you or others while speaking. Avoid fiddling with your hair. One should try and reach the venue 15minutes earlier so as to get acclimatized to the place and people and at the same time be able to find the optimum place for sitting in a GD. This will help the candidate to register her/his presence properly.

Body language

The candidate should be attentive, assertive and alert so as to show her/his interest, seriousness and commitment. Make proper eye contact with all the team members and should not look towards or address the moderator while speaking. You should make controlled and modest hand gestures else they can distract other people or may look offending. Do not point your finger on anyone or make aggressive gestures.



Tips to Ace Your Group Discussion

Maintain eye contact with team members and not evaluators. They're not a part of the discussion. Ensure that you get to speak your

point, if the other members hear you, the evaluators will too.

Having said that, ensure that you listen as well and appreciate what others are saying. If you do not agree with someone's point, let them complete and then raise your objection. Do not interrupt. Page - 1

And was he dissenting against democracy?



in Plato's writings are debates concerning the best possible form of government, featuring adherents of aristocracy, democracy, monarchy as well as other issues. A central theme is the conflict between nature and convention, concerning the role of heredity and the environment on human intelligence and personality long before the modern "nature versus nurture" debate began in the time of Thomas Hobbes and John Locke, with its modern continuation in such controversial works as The Mismeasure of Man and The Bell Curve.

Another key distinction and theme in the Platonic corpus is the dichotomy between knowledge and opinion, which foreshadow modern debates between David Hume and Immanuel Kant, and has been taken up by postmodernists and their opponents, more commonly as the distinction between the 'objective' and the 'subjective'.

Even the story of the lost city or continent of Atlantis came to us as an illustrative story told by Plato in his Timaeus and Critias.

Plato wrote mainly in the form known as dialogue. In the early dialogues, several characters discuss a topic by asking questions of one another. Socrates figures prominently, and a lively, more disorganized form of elenchos/dialectic is present; these are called The Socratic Dialogues. Yes, he was dissenting against democracy. It's very hard for us to recapture how radical this was. Athens was the first democracy at this time — there are others, but it's the most powerful. It has these moments of inner turmoil, the oligarchic coups I mentioned earlier, arising from tensions of internal politics exacerbated by fighting a war against Sparta and her allies that Athens eventually lost. This is the first regime in which the majority of common people — people who are poor and may not own any property, who are maybe artisans or tenant farmers — actually have political power. To win success in politics you have to speak in terms that they are going to approve of, as members of the assembly and popular juries. That leads to a certain idea of what knowledge is, or what power is, what one should aim at. That's what Plato, and others like him, were criticising.
