Whereas, the Parties agree to work together to collaborate to enable certifying teachers and student teachers based on the framework designed by EDINDIA

Now therefore, the Parties hereby agree as follows:

Article 1 - Objectives

By the present Agreement, EdIndia and the Partner agree, through joint and concerted cooperation, to to develop an ICT-enabled eco-system for pre-service teacher education.

Article 2 - Joint Projects

- 1. When an individual project is later identified and approved, for each project, the parties will sign a binding agreement, hereinafter referred to as "Project Agreement", which will be contained within the framework of this Agreement, and which will define the rights and obligations of the parties.
- 2. Each Project Agreement will determine, in particular,
 - (i) the objectives of the project,
 - (ii) the activities involved in the project,
 - (iii) the specific obligations of each Party,
 - (iv) the specific modalities and conditions for the execution of the project, including evaluation
 - (v) the budget for the project,
 - (vi) the duration of each project.

Article 3 - Deliverables of EdIndia

- EdIndia will conduct regular online sessions and engagement activities for the preservice student teachers on the topics mapped with syllabus.
- 2. EdIndia will set up e-platforms and provide e-content access to pre-service student teachers
- 3. Edindia will assist pre-service student teachers to get enrolled in the professional courses offered by renowned agencies.
- EdIndia to share periodic updates/reports with college authorities, and improvise on the programs as per the on ground requirements.

Article 4 - Obligations of the Partner

- 1. The Partner agrees to execute the terms of the present Agreement.
- 2. The Partner agrees to provide support to Edindia's work.
- 3. Provide requisite data to the team as and when required to maximize the program effectiveness.

Article 5 - Guilding Principles

When carrying out the Project, each party shall:

- 1. Collaborate and co-operate with the other party;
- communicate directly about any major concerns, issues or opportunities relating to the Project of which it becomes aware;
- 3. Share information, experience, materials and skills with the other party and develop effective working practices, and work collaboratively with the other party to identify solutions, eliminate duplication of effort, mitigate risk and reduce cost;
- 4. Adhere to statutory requirements and best practice and comply with applicable laws and standards
- 5. Act in a timely manner and respond to reasonable requests from the other party within a reasonable period;
- 6. Manage stakeholders effectively;

Article 6 - Media activities

- 1. The projects, their conception, their implementation, their development, their impact and their outcome will necessitate informational and promotional activities at the initiative of and on the part of the Parties, separately or jointly.
- 2. Each Party is authorized to use the name and the logo and any element of the other's identity, through the use of citations, references to, representations on the occasion of the promotion of projects, of public relations operations, of interviews, of relations with the media (press files, articles, releases etc.) throughout the world. This use, which must adhere to the image of the concerned party, must receive the prior and written consent by Edindia when it relates to information activities external to the Partner.
- 3. The media and information support (films, photographic pictures, etc.), as well as all the rights related to them, will belong exclusively to the Party who makes and finances them. They can only be used by the other Party after the latter obtains the prior consent of the proprietary party. Notwithstanding that, the proprietary party can refuse to authorize their use if the rights given up (copyright, trademark) do not cover the foreseen exploitations.





Article 7 - General Conditions

Use of the Name, Emblem or Official Seal of Edindia

Unless authorized in writing by Edindia, the Partner shall not use the name, acronym or official logo of EDINDIA, or any abbreviation of the name of Edindia, for advertising or any other purposes.

2. Status of the Partner

Nothing in this Agreement shall be construed as establishing a legal partnership (such as, by way of clarification, partnership liability), joint venture, agency, exclusive arrangement or other similar relationship. Neither the Partner nor anyone whom it may employ shall be considered as an agent of Edindia or a member of the staff of Edindia and, except as otherwise provided herein, shall not be entitled to any privileges, immunities, compensation or reimbursements, nor shall be authorized to commit Edindia to any expenditure or other obligations.

3. Conformity with Laws

Both parties agree to respect the laws of the country – India and guarantees that it will not permit any official to receive a direct or indirect profit from this Agreement.

4. Settlements of Disputes

All disputes arising out of or in connection with the present Agreement shall be settled by mutual understanding. However, if no amicable settlement can be arrived at, any dispute shall be arbitrated according to the rules defined by law of the land at location -Jaipur, Rajasthan

5. Termination

Should either Party fail to meet its obligations, the other Party may terminate the present Agreement upon 3 (three) months' written notice to the other Party. The same will apply with respect to incidents making the realization of the Project extremely hazardous.

6. Amendment

This Agreement, including this provision, may not be waived, modified or changed in any manner except by a written amendment signed by each of the parties hereto.

7. Non-exclusivity

It is understood that this Agreement does not confer the either Party any exclusivity regarding activities such as those covered by this Agreement, and the Partner accepts that EdIndia is currently collaborating on similar activities worldwide with other partners.





Article 8 - Notification
