





What is Drama?

Drama is simply referred to as a form of fiction which is represented in a performance in a theatre, radio or TV, and in any of its performing arts such as plays, mime, ballet, musical, etc. The word 'drama' is actually taken from the Greek word 'drama'/'draw' which also refers to 'I do' or action. Thus, acting or performing action comes in play through theatrical, radio, TV or live performances of a fictional story.

1. **Teaches Self-Expression:** Children learn about the importance of self-expression through the use of drama and arts in education and


through creative expression, their perception and worldview are broader which equips them with the skills to face adversities late in life.
