



Report on Blood Donation Camp

Date: 02 September 2021

Venue: Biyani Girls B.Ed. College, Jaipur

Objective:


PROGRAM OVERVIEW







This program is an attempt in the direction of holistic development of the preservice students. The program consists of four components as mentioned:



BGBC (Biyani Girls B.Ed. College) is run by Biyani Shiksha Samiti in Jaipur since 2006. ALC partnered with the BGBC to implement the program with the students of B.ED., M.Ed., and D.E.Ed courses.
